

Study Abroad Program: INDIGENOUS PLANNING EXCHANGE PROGRAM/IPEX

IPEX provides funding to Arizona State University senior undergraduate and graduate students in planning, geography and closely related fields, to study in Mexico or Canada. Students interested in indigenous planning have the opportunity to pursue their studies at partner universities for one semester without paying additional tuition or losing credits toward their degree program. The award allows the unique opportunity to engage and interact with faculty, students and indigenous communities in a learning environment in Winnipeg, Saskatoon, Puebla or San Cristobal.



Upper-level undergraduate students and graduate students from planning, geography and related studies are welcome to apply:

- ❑ Students must have a 3.0 GPA in their major.
- ❑ Students will receive full semester credits (12-15 hours) at their own university.
- ❑ For study in Mexico, an allowance of up to \$1000 is available for intensive language study.
- ❑ \$3000 per semester is awarded for airfare, basic room and board, and living expenses.
