

The Bachelor of Science in Planning (BSP)/Master of Urban and Environmental Planning (MUEP) Accelerated Degree program allows you to fast track your Master’s program by starting your coursework in your senior year. You are able to take up to 18 credit hours of graduate coursework in your senior year. In order to successfully complete the program, you will complete 47 or 48 graduate credit hours depending on your culminating experience.

The below curriculum outlines the requirements of the MUEP program. Please consult your undergraduate advisor if you have questions regarding your BSP major. All graduate coursework should be taken in the order as described. If you will need to deviate from the below plan, please contact the Graduate Advisor to review your options.

\*Courses have an undergraduate equivalent. In order to ensure that the class will count for credit towards MUEP, you must enroll in the 500+ course as indicated above. PUP 598 is an MUEP elective but the undergraduate equivalent (PUP 410) is required for the BSP degree. It is recommended that students take PUP 598 so that it may count toward both degree programs. PUP 531 is required for the MUEP so should be taken instead of the undergraduate equivalent (PUP 432).

\*\*Culminating experience options are a traditional capstone PUP 580 (5), a professional project PUP 593 (5) or a thesis PUP 599 (6)
